How will we track progress of children over time?

Golden Codes! - Emerging, Developing, Secure The Golden Codes and tracking scheme are the back-bone to track progress

across the school these will be recorded as the year group followed by the code, for example: <mark>Yr3E</mark> (Year 3 Emerging), <mark>Yr4S</mark> (Year 4 Secure).

We will be replacing APS (average point scores) with Tracking Points. Tracking Points can be used to examine progress and attainment numerically (as an average).

The Tracking Point scale starts at Tracking Point 1, which is the first term in the first year in Nursery. This can then be counted up to Tracking Point 15 (the end of Year 2) and Tracking Point 27 (the end of Year 6).

All year groups move on 3 tracking points in a year, one for each of the golden codes. <u>Expectation is that children make 12 months progress in 12 months.</u>
